Musica Viva School Program

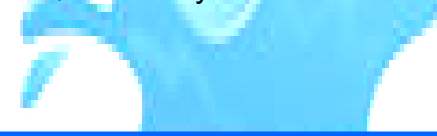

We also enjoy making items out of blocks and 3-D Shapes. On Wednesdays, Miss Fields helps us with working mathematically and solving problems based on the weekly outcomes.
