“The NAPLAN exams that our Year 3 and Year 5 children will sit/start this week. I know you are really anxious for your child to do well.

However, please remember, amongst the students who will be sitting for the exams;

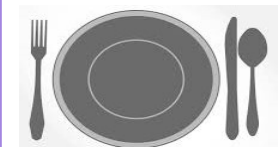
Sound Waves
